WHEREAS, Reverend Prosper Lebastard, Reverend Joseph Haquin, Reverend Edward Travert and Reverend Joseph Dream, Directors of the College at Caraquet, in the County of Gloucester, have been incorporated under the name of The College of the Sacred Heart, Caraquet, in the year 1900;

AND WHEREAS, it is desired to change the corporate name of the said "The College of the Sacred Heart, Caraquet," to that of "Le College du Sacre Coeur, Bathurst, "and to increase the borrowing powers conferred under the terms of the said Act;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Lieutenant-

Governor and Legislative Assembly, as follows:

Notwithstanding anything contained in the preamble to the Act, or any section of the Act incorporating "The College of the Sacred Heart, Caraquet, "the said incorporators and their successors are and they are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate under the name of "Le College du Sacre Coeur, Bathurst, "with all the powers and privileges conferred upon the said incorporators under the said Act.

There shall be an annual meeting of the Board of Governors at such time and place, in the Province of New Brunswick, as may from time to time be fixed by the Board, and it shall be the duty of the Board at the first meeting held after the passing of this Act, or adjournment thereof, to prescribe the time and place for holding such annual meeting.

3. Section 14 of the said Act, 1900, is hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" in the last line thereof, and substituting therefor the word sixty.

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
